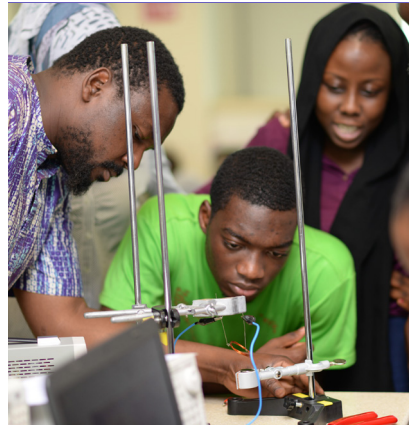


# 2021 HIGHLIGHTS



**1,339** students enrolled

Ashesi's undergraduate Class of 2025 represented 20% of applicants to Ashesi this year, with 345 being enrolled.



**9th** place ranking in Africa

Ashesi was ranked among the world's top 400 most impactful universities in the 2021 Global Times Higher Education (THE) University Impact Rankings. We also ranked second in Ghana.



**47%** of students are women

The university has built a strong reputation around empowering African women as university graduates and strives to maintain gender balance in the student body.



**43%** of students are on scholarships

Increasing female enrolment is a priority for our team. More than half of the students receiving scholarships are women.



**28** countries represented

Our international student population accounts for 17% of the student body, with 24 out of the 28 countries represented on campus being African.



**133** jobs have been created through the Ghana Climate Innovation Centre (GCIC)

The GCIC, a business incubator growing Ghana's green economy, has cumulatively supported 101 businesses, 31 of which are women-owned or led.



**90%** of alumni secure quality placement within 6 months

Ashesi alumni are working in all sectors of the economy: growing local and international businesses, building and sustaining NGOs, and designing solutions to community problems.



**149,000** students impacted by the Education Collaborative

Through an affiliation of institutions across Sub-Saharan Africa, the initiative aims to transform over 1.1 million students to be critical, entrepreneurial leaders who create jobs, transform industries and lead economies by 2030.

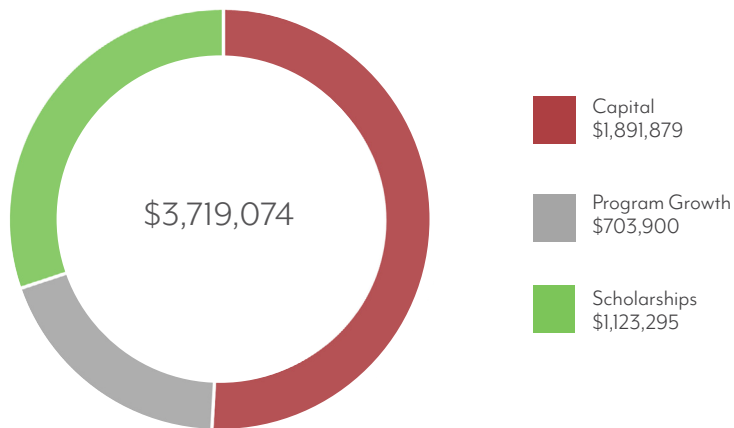

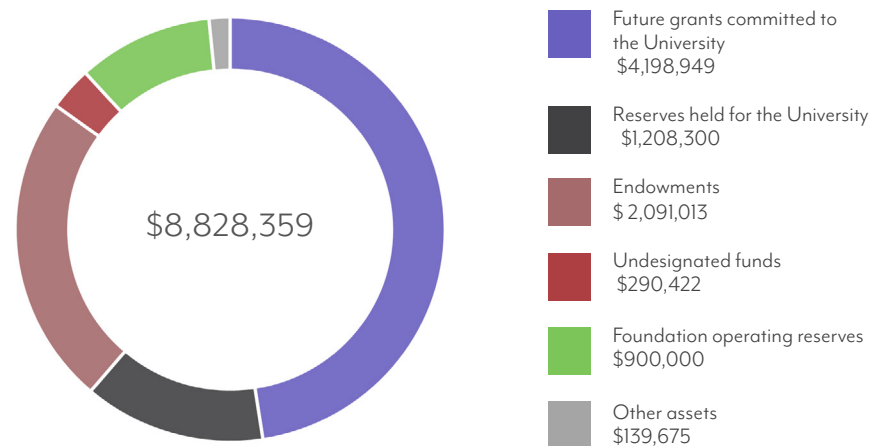
